- The Mt Buller Sprint caters to all types of vehicles, combining the challenges of hill climb and tarmac rally, run over a 16 kilometre closed road stage on excellent fully sealed tarmac surface from the foot of Mt Buller climbing to the resort township on the mountain's peak.
- Competitors can expect to have a minimum of eight (8) runs over 2 days
- PLUS a full speed shake down run and a prologue.

### **The Mt Buller Sprint is open to**

- Modern cars – classified as post 1982
- Classic cars – classified as pre 1982
- Modern & Classic cars are then divided into many groups according to vehicle age groups, engine capacity and modification based class and category considerations
- AND FOR THE FIRST TIME this year's event will be running a new category for Muscle Cars that will be divided into 2 unique groups
- Early 1966 to 1971
- Late 1972 to 1978
