At the summit there is a stone distance dial and a fire tower that is manned during the summer months.

But probably the fastest way up to Mt Buller is as an entry in the November 1 – 3, 2008, Mt Buller Sprint. The Mt Buller Sprint being arguably Australia's greatest tarmac hill climb for race and tarmac rally cars.
